Inappropriate behaviour

The following behaviour will not be tolerated:

- Harassment, bullying and/or intimidation, false accusations, threats and assault, as well as sexual harassment in public or in private.
- Plagiarism and fabrication of data and results.
- Using the event to promote hate or discriminatory speech, or to infringe on the rights of others.
- Discrimination of any kind, such as on the basis of religion, disability, age, national origin, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression.
- Discrimination includes the use of derogatory comments/slurs.
- Impersonation of other persons or entities, as well as falsely claiming the ownership of scientific titles, professional positions, or affiliations.

Harassment may include, but is not limited to:

- Inappropriate comments related to gender, gender identity and expression, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, age, and religion.
- The display of sexual images.
- Deliberate intimidation, stalking, or following.
- Harassing photography or recording.
- Sustained disruption of talks or other events.
- Inappropriate physical contact.
- Unwelcome sexual attention.
- Advocating for, or encouraging, any of the above behaviour.
